

Game/Point Options

Bier Barrel Bowling

Did you know the German word for bowling is Kegln? Inspired by the German word, trade in your bowling ball for mini Spaten kegs and bowl for points. Each participant will use a mini keg and bowl down a 16 ft. lane into traditional bowling pins. Participants must be 21 or older to participate.

Team Information: Each team will be allowed one bowler

Points: Participant will receive one point per pin knocked down

German Spelling Bee

Each group will be given 15 German words from the emcee that they must, as a team, figure out how to spell. Each correct word will earn one point!

Team Information: Entire team can participate

Points: Each word spelled correctly will earn one point

Bier Barrel Rolling

Watch as teams from around the area compete in a fun, bier barrel rolling relay. Participants will use one hand to roll a Spaten bier barrel down to the finish line and pass it off to their partner, who has to do the same thing. Participants must keep the keg within their lane and will be penalized 15 seconds every time the barrel hits the line. Participants must be 21 years or older to participate. All teams will be timed and the fastest time wins.

Team Information: Each team will be allowed 1 2-person relay team

Points: 3 points for first place; 2 points for second place; 1 point for 3rd place

Stein Race

See how fast your team can run while trying to keep the bier in the stein! Each team will line up with a full stein of bier, and then each member of the team will have to race to the other end and back while going thru an obstacle course; then pour the bier into the next participant's stein. The team with the most bier at the end wins the challenge! Participants must be 21 years or older to participate.

Team Information: Entire team can participate; if a team has less than 10 team members some members may have to go numerous times.

Points: 3 points for first place; 2 points for second place; 1 point for 3rd place

Pretzel Toss

Imagine a game of horseshoes played with giant pretzels: Contestants toss large pretzels onto a target on the ground. Points are awarded based on how close to the center they fall.

Points: 5 points for first place; 3 points for second place; 1 point for 3rd place.

Authentic dress

Dress in authentic attire, including Lederhosen and traditional German Dirndl and get participation points!

Team Information: Entire team can participate

Points: Each team member that dresses in authentic attire gets 5 points

Volunteer at Oktoberfest

Don't want to play the games? But are interested in volunteering? Get a point for every hour that is worked! Volunteers are needed from 5pm – 8pm on Thursday to assist with the challenge. This would include check-in and setting up challenges.

Team Information: Anyone from organization that is not participating in the challenge can volunteer. Space is limited; filled on first come first serve.

Points: Team members get one point for every hour volunteered.
